– what do we need to consider?



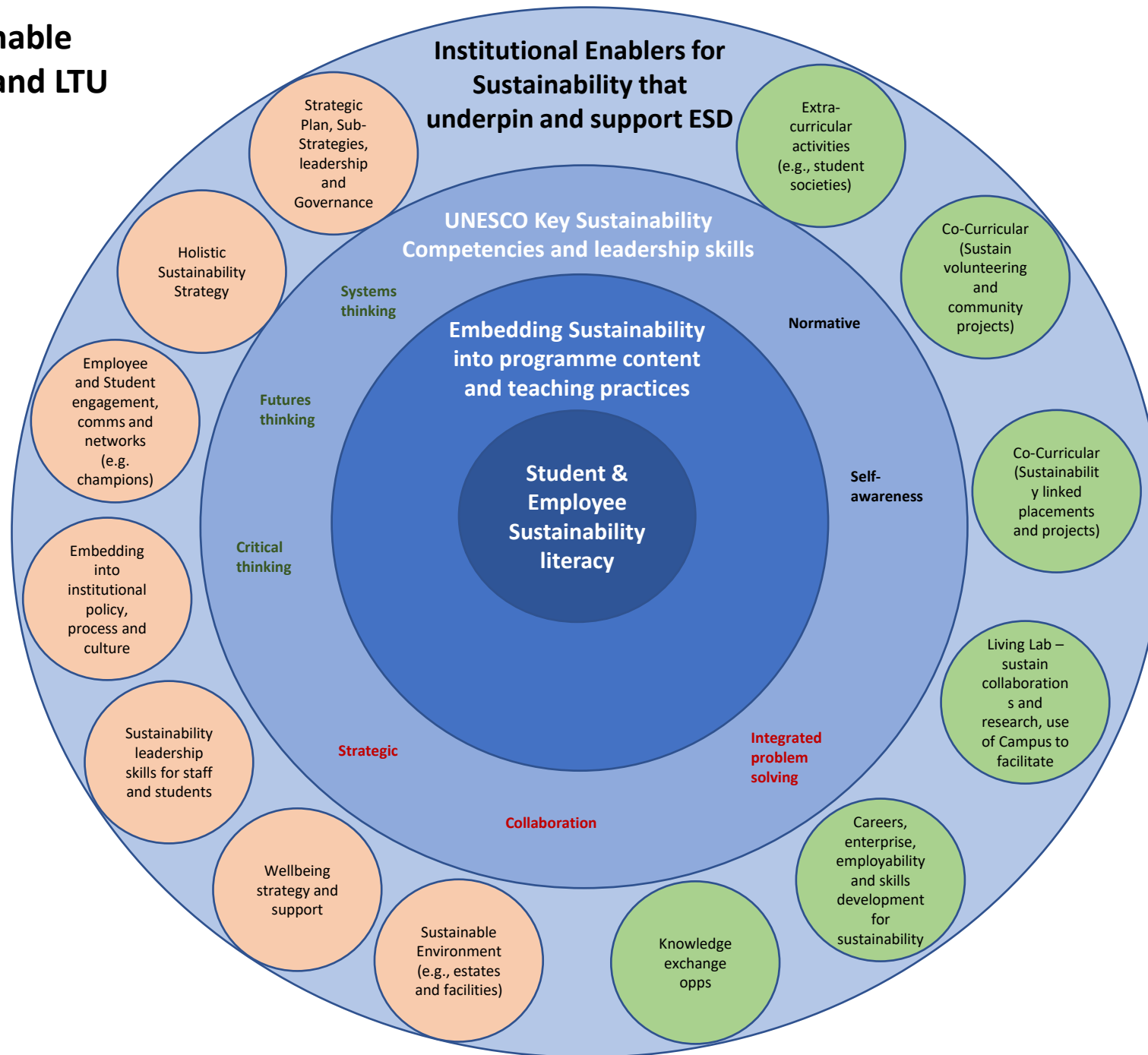
